




Today's philosophy: "I'm going to do the least that is expected of me, and I'm going to try to get the most out of it that I can."






The first mile: she supplied the servant with water


Remember the Lord your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant he confirmed to your ancestors with an oath.



- Step out and ask God to give you a generous life mentality!




