GOAL: *To become women who do womanhood well.*

Scripture focus: Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. (ESV)

"stir" (Greek: *paroxusmos*):

In a good sense, a \_\_\_\_\_; used figuratively meaning an \_\_\_\_\_ to some action or feeling.

- Implies movement toward a certain point
- To sharpen the mind, temper, or courage of someone...
